

Park Pittman United Methodist Church, MOBILE MED
Statesboro, GA
October 12 -18, 2014

Dr. Randy Smith and his team from Pittman Park United Methodist Church, Statesboro, GA, arrived on Sunday, Oct 12th. They began preparing their supplies for the daily trip to the mobile med sites. We were scheduled for two different sites (two days at one, three days at another). Sabine, the Health Center Administrator, worked over the weekend to change the first site location as it was no longer accessible due to the substantial rains on the previous Friday and Saturday night. The communities we served are remote areas of the district or zone covered by our Health Center.

The team provided care to 708 patients in five days including Hope House staff. One notable patient was a 96 year old woman that walked to the clinic and back home unaided. Her hip was sore due to a fall. It was the first time she had ever seen a doctor. Many babies were seen, some in quite distress. We were able to refer them to local facilities for additional care with follow –up to be provided by Dr. Joseph at the Health Center.
